Regularly set aside time for prayer and listening to God as He speaks through His Holy Spirit		
Am intentional in loving others and encouraging them to serve God with their lives		
Connect with others to help keep me accountable and on track		

<i>Related to the Youth Transition Program, I</i>	Self Assessment	My Confidant's Assessment
Value the opportunity to invest in the lives of young people to encourage them to be all that God has made them to be		
Find that young people often welcome my involvement in their lives		
Am generally patient with young people while they develop, even if their progress seems slow		
Understand that supporting a youth to discover their own resources and solutions (rather than doing things for them) is the best way I can help youth develop into mature individuals		
Appreciate the need for creating a safe coaching environment and recognize that mutual trust, respect, honesty and openness are critical in fostering a healthy coaching relationship		
Recognize that failure is often a part of growth		
Am able to devote roughly one hour a week for one year connecting with a youth
